Another important factor for engagement in discussion was group accountability for case **This**ies encouraged students to expand itheommunication channels beyond the discussion board within the Learning Management. Students even started using personal **destages**, emails, and telephone calls to discuss plans, logistics, problems, deadlines, and their cases outside the online. **Cassical** methods and content discussions became more divergent, engaging, and frequent than those of online discussions. Roleplaying activity incorporated with the IDEAL approach allowed students to learn ways of solving problems, which is requisite to the teaching profession filled **-stitutiu**red problems.
